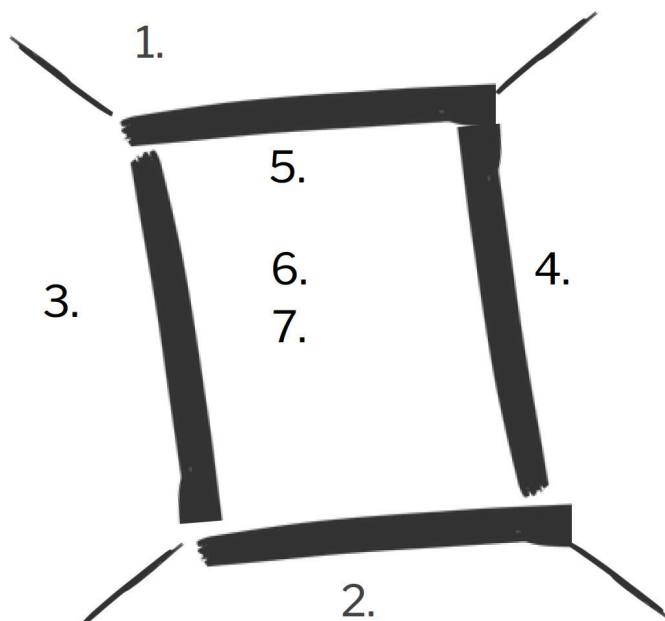

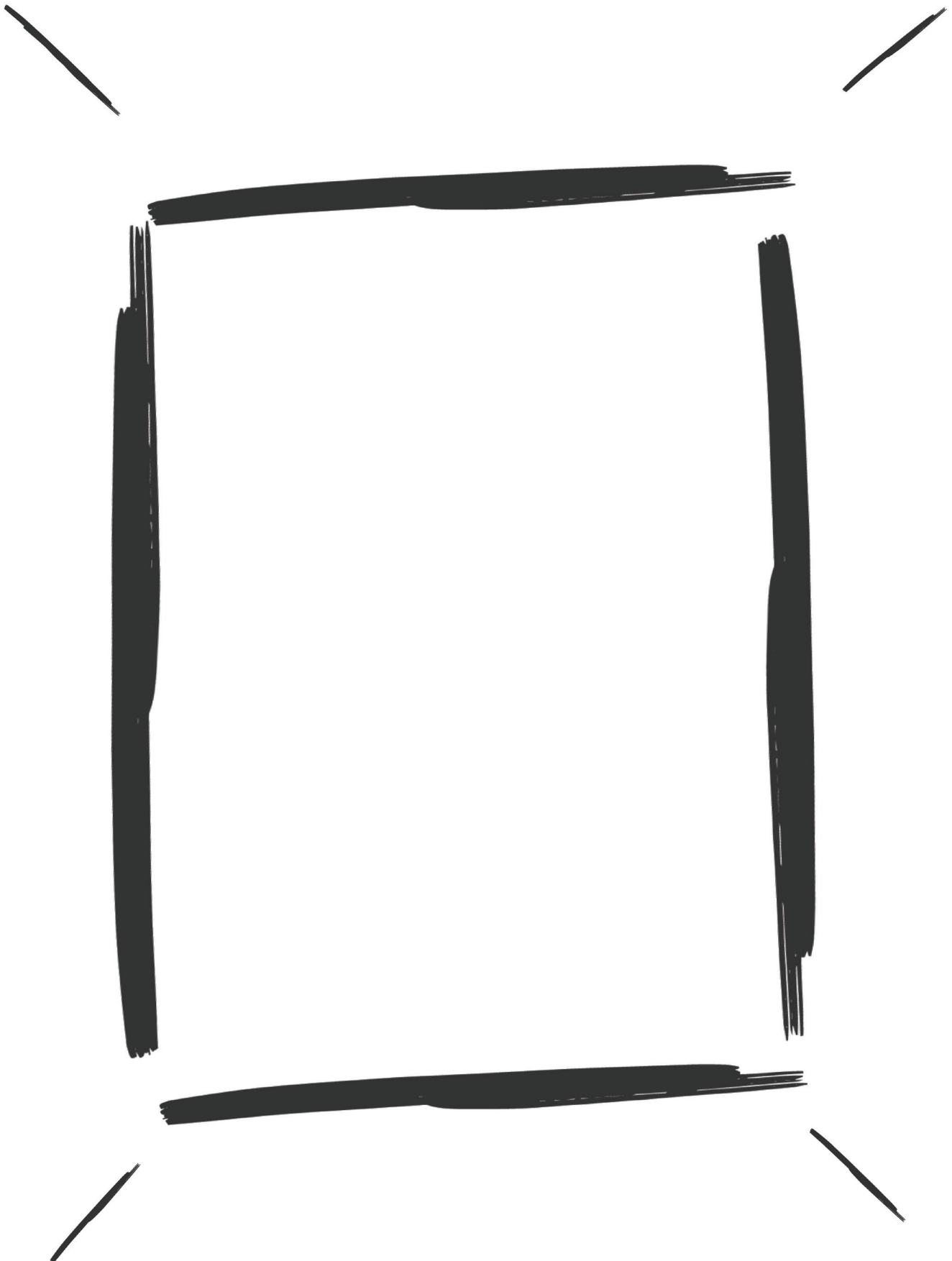
Guiding Question

7. Underneath each picture, explain how each illustration depicts the principle.
